## FIELD USE POLICY

Iberia Soccer Association (ISA) strives to maintain a standard of excellence on our Soccer Fields and through a cooperative endeavor with the PepperPlex we strive to provide a place of fun and recreation for children of this parish and surrounding parishes. This policy is intended to avoid schedule conflicts since ISA activities and field maintenance go on throughout the entire year and in order to ensure the safety of ISA Teams and other local area teams requesting to use the soccer fields and we ask that the following procedures be followed.

To request use of any of Soccer Fields maintained and used by Iberia Soccer Association (Fields 1 – 10) please complete a Field Reservation Form and email it to [iberiasoccer@yahoo.com](mailto:iberiasoccer@yahoo.com) no less than one week before your requested date/dates for approval and Field Assignment.

**Local High School Organizations requesting to use the fields for Practice will not be charged a fee but teams must abide by ISA policies and may only use fields assigned that day.**

**Local High School Organizations / Other Area Organizations requesting to use a Field/Fields for a Game will be charged a fee of \$50.00/per GAME.**

### Responsibilities of Team

- Throw away all trash around bench and spectator areas.
- Respect all Facility and Parking Areas. Clean up after your team and spectators.
- Any cancellations should be sent to Iberia Soccer as soon as possible.
- IF IT RAINS DURING THE DAY it is your responsibility to contact ISA to ensure that fields are playable.

### ISA Responsibilities

- Cutting and Painting Fields for Game days of play. Practice fields will not be painted.
- ISA will check fields and make a decision by noon if fields are unplayable.

### Violation of Field Use Policy

Iberia Soccer Association's Protest and Dispute Committee will be responsible for issuing all offenses and providing documentation of offense to teams and the Pepperplex Commission. A team may dispute any offense by emailing [iberiasoccer@yahoo.com](mailto:iberiasoccer@yahoo.com) within 48 hours of being notified of offense. A meeting will be scheduled to review the findings of the offense and the basis of the decision.

- First Offense will result in a fine of \$50.00 to be paid before next usage of fields.
- Second Offense will result in a fine of \$100.00 to be paid before next usage of fields and a two week suspension from fields.
- Third Offense will result in a fine of \$200.00 to be paid before next usage and suspension for the remainder of the High School Season.
